Highlights

- **Why we march:** We march in defense of American democracy, the rule of law, and a livable planet, because our nation belongs to its people, not to kings. We honor those who fought for our freedom, including the 400,000 Americans who died fighting fascism in World War II, thousands of whom are buried in nearby Arlington Cemetery.
- **When and Where:** Kick-off program at 10:00 AM at [1 Memorial Circle, Washington, DC 20566](#)). Around 10:30 we begin to march: across the bridge, past the Lincoln Memorial, and along the Reflecting Pool to Constitution Gardens, about 1.6 miles, where we will gather for a brief celebratory drum, chant and song circle. Cherry Blossom Festival traffic restrictions mean we cannot march on the streets in DC. Crossing Memorial Bridge will be one of the best parts of the march!
- **Getting There:** Take the Blue Line to Arlington Cemetery, allowing 10 minutes to walk from the Metro stop to Memorial Circle. If you drive, you can park at Fashion Centre at Pentagon City and take Metro two stops to Arlington Cemetery. There is no parking near Memorial Circle, but you can be dropped near the Metro entrance on Memorial Ave. There may be construction delays on the GW Parkway. Please check Saturday morning and plan accordingly.
- **What to Bring:** Bring a friend, a full water bottle, a snack, and sunscreen. Also welcome: costumes, homemade signs and banners, American flags, bucket drums! Help keep our parks clean by picking up litter and carrying away anything you bring.

- **How You Can Help:** We need people with full hearts and empty hands to help carry our fabulous banners and protest art! We also need somebody to pull a wagon with our mobile speaker and set it up at the end of the march. [Use our Volunteer Form to sign up for these and other important jobs.](#)

We will march from Memorial Circle, across Memorial Bridge, on the north side of the Lincoln Monument, then east along the north side of the reflecting pool, ending at Constitution Gardens. Due to the Cherry Blossom Festival, we cannot march on the streets in Washington DC. The highlight of the march will be crossing the bridge. There are bathrooms at the Arlington

Cemetery Visitors Center, and north of the Reflecting Pool.
